It is imperative to note that all items must be in good, working condition, and we will not accept items that are dirty, torn, or stained.

Please include information about the weight and dimensions of your item(s) in your email. Additionally, including a photo of your item is always helpful. Thank you for your support!

Kitchen: pots and pans, silverware sets, dish sets, dish towels, crock pots and pressure cookers, glasses and mugs (*we cannot accept wine glasses, beer steins, shot glasses, etc.)

Bathroom: bath and hand towels, bath mat (new only), shower curtains (new only), toilet paper, hand soap, toilet brush (new only)

Bedroom: mattresses, bed frames, dressers, sheet sets (new only), comforters and duvets, pillows (new only)

Living Room: televisions and video game consoles, lightweight art or decorative pieces, lamps (*please remove lightbulb)

Furniture: coffee tables, bedside tables, chairs, bookshelves

We do NOT accept the following items for donation:

- used space heaters
- used socks
- used underwear
- children's clothing
- business professional clothing
- clothing that is more than ten years old
- Items that are stained, torn, or in need of repair

- Used or expired cosmetic or hygiene items
- Diva cups and other reusable period products
- Hand sanitizer
- Fresh produce, refrigerated food, or prepared meals
- Used socks and/or underwear
- Business/professional attire
- Children's clothing, toys, or stuffed animals
- Paraphernalia suited for alcohol, marijuana, etc.
- Any item that names or depicts a brand of alcohol, marijuana, etc.
- Couches or loveseats
- Furniture that is covered in pet hair
- Furniture with glass in it
- Outdoor furniture and equipment
- Wrap-around desks
- Exercise equipment
- Large appliances
